Introduction

Kilkenny LEADER Partnership (KLP) is the Local Action Group delivering the European Union's flagship programme for rural development: LEADER.

KLP continues to focus on retaining the bottom up and innovative projects we have always championed. Consultations on the design and focus of the new Local Development Strategy took place around the county earlier in the year, with community groups, small businesses, local partners and company stakeholders. These meetings garnered valuable information that reflects the needs and priorities of the local area.

The consultations empowered communities and stakeholders to shape the LEADER development process. It also, contributed to finding new and creative solutions to local challenges and assisted with the development of the new LEADER programme strategy.

As a result of the consultations and the information gathered, KLP has structured the themes and strategies for the new LEADER programme.

The 2023– 2027 LEADER Programme has a significantly reduced budget of €180 million for the country. County Kilkenny has been allocated €6.1 million in total from this national allocation. The Local Development Strategy has been assigned a provisional budget for the upcoming five-year period.









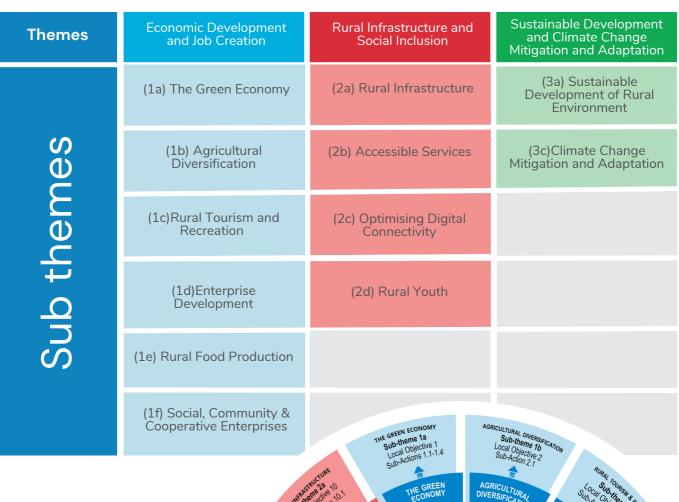

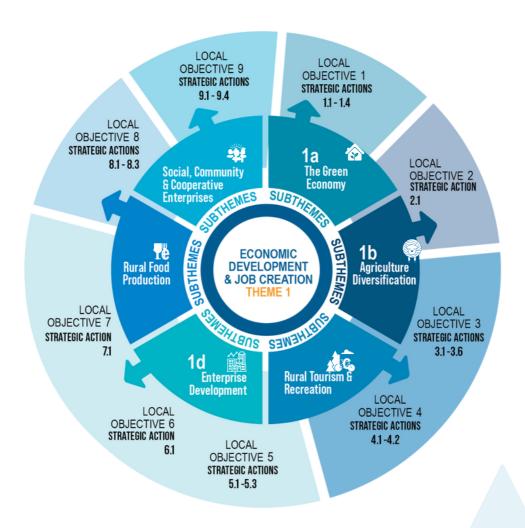

THEME 1

Economic Development and Job Creation



Sub-theme (1 a): The Green Economy

Local Objective 1: Building community capacity to develop and sustain a local circular economy and support initiatives towards community benefit from renewable energy.

STRATEGIC ACTION 1.1

Renewable Energy Initiatives: Support the development of sustainable and renewable energy initiatives in County Kilkenny

STRATEGIC ACTION 1.2

Energy Town Expansion: The expansion and network support of the Kilkenny Energy Town model.

STRATEGIC ACTION 1.3

Circular Economy Cooperation: Cooperating with Irish partners LAGs on the development of Circular Economy initiatives.

STRATEGIC ACTION 1.4

Enterprise Environmental Initiatives: Support rural enterprises to adopt new technologies or engage in environmental initiatives.

Rural Tourism and Recreation

THEME 1 continued

Sub-theme (1 b) Agricultural Diversification

Local Objective 2: Creation of more economically and socially sustainable value chains for the sale of farm products, by encouraging 'coopetition' between stakeholders

STRATEGIC ACTION 2.1

Wool Value Chain Development: Cooperating with other LDCs in localising 'high-quality wool' sheep breeds, and the wool-supply and woven products value chain for craft textiles.

Sub-theme (1 c): Rural Tourism and Recreation

Local Objective 3: Optimise the tourism and recreation opportunities that County Kilkenny's landscape assets offer to visitors and residents.

STRATEGIC ACTION 3.1

Walking Route Development: Development of off-road walking trails, close to towns and villages.

STRATEGIC ACTION 3.2

Greenway Linkage: Expand and develop linkages to greenways to increase the reach and connectivity of Kilkenny as a tourism offering.

STRATEGIC ACTION 3.3

Outdoor & Adventure Amenities: Development of outdoor and adventure recreational amenities.

STRATEGIC ACTION 3.4

Barrow- Blackstairs Development: Cooperation project to develop the Barrow Valley & Blackstairs tourism as an integrated tourism region.

STRATEGIC ACTION 3.5

Town Boating Amenities & Culture: Developing recreational and boating amenities on key towns and rivers, including cultural events.

STRATEGIC ACTION 3.6

Open Water Swimming Amenities: Develop the potential of dedicated urban-based, openwater swimming amenities at appropriate sites in County Kilkenny.

Local Objective 4: Expanding visitor accommodation capacity through a wider range of innovative and complementary offerings to the range of accommodation in rural Kilkenny.

STRATEGIC ACTION 4.1

Dispersed Hotels: Develop the concept of 'Dispersed Hotels' in rural regions of County Kilkenny where multi-site accommodation offerings are integrated under one 'Umbrella Brand'.

STRATEGIC ACTION 4.2

Hostel & Campervan: Support the development of quality accommodation focusing on hostel and campervan facilities aimed at tourists and other visitors in selected rural areas of Kilkenny.

Local Objective 5: Realising the social and economic potential of Kilkenny's unique cultural heritage and hidden histories.

STRATEGIC ACTION 5.1

Local History Archive: Explore the capacity to develop a Kilkenny Local History Archive to collect, conserve and share historical documents, maps and artefacts unique to Kilkenny.

STRATEGIC ACTION 5.2

Heritage & Tourism: Promote the sensitive utilisation of selected heritage sites as a driver of tourism in Ireland's Ancient East.

STRATEGIC ACTION 5.3

Recording Local History: Support communities to sustainably record and celebrate their local history and shared experiences.

Rural Food Production

THEME 1 continued

Sub-theme (1 d): Enterprise Development

Local Objective 6: Support the potential to achieve economies of scale and scope through the development of regional clusters of expertise in specialities based in Kilkenny and the South-East Region.

STRATEGIC ACTION 6.1

Support Local Enterprise Specialities: Development of a South-East enterprise cluster of expertise and manufacturing in the cement and engineering specialities of Kilkenny and the South-East Region.

Local Objective 7: Harnessing Kilkenny's international accreditation as a world craft council 'Craft City & Region' to support enterprise development and tourism potential in the indigenous crafts and wider creative sectors.

STRATEGIC ACTION 7.1

Innovative Enterprise Support: Adding value to new or innovative enterprises with strategic potential to create significant employment.

Sub-theme (1 e): Rural Food Production

Local Objective 8: Expanding the range and capacity of local food enterprises in Kilkenny.

STRATEGIC ACTION 8.1

Kilkenny Food Strategy: Progressing Kilkenny Food Strategy 2020-2025 through the development and/or expansion of local food enterprises

STRATEGIC ACTION 8.2

Food Hub: Developing a regional food hub for research, incubation, development, training and cooperation.

STRATEGIC ACTION 8 3

Online Trading System: Cooperation on developing an online food verification & trading system with other regional and likeminded LDC partners to grow the market for local food produce.

Sub-theme (1 f): Social. Community & Cooperative Enterprises

Local Objective 9: Developing the capacity of local communities to plan for their future in a sustainable and 'Smart' mannerBuilding the sustainable capacity of local communities to plan for their future in a 'Smart' manner.

STRATEGIC ACTION 9.1

Smart Village Cooperation Project - The Next Stage: 'Smarter & Stronger Together'.

STRATEGIC ACTION 9.2

Town Ecologies: Expanding and embedding coherent, community-led, participatory planning (such as KLP's 'Town Ecologies' model) with formal planning processes.

STRATEGIC ACTION 9.3

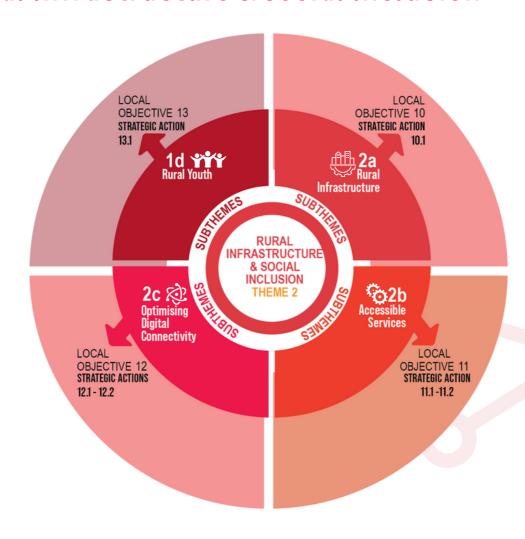
Peer Mentoring Training: Sharing successful practices in community development through the 'Community Champion' Peer Mentoring and Training Programme.

Sub-theme (2 b): Accessible Services

Local Objective 11: Supporting the development of an inclusive mobility strategy for rural Kilkenny, including linkage to regional and national services, and helping communities to optimise active travel options.

STRATEGIC ACTION 11.1

Public Transport Integration: Integration of public transport systems in Kilkenny to enhance connectivity and accessibility.

STRATEGIC ACTION 11.2

Active Travel: Support the development of community-led local travel Initiatives based on the principles of the 'Active Travel' principles.

THEME 2 continued

Sub-theme (2 c): Optimising Digital Connectivity

Local Objective 12: Optimising the digital connectivity of Kilkenny's rural communities, visitors and enterprises, and enhancing heritage site.

STRATEGIC ACTION 12.1

Community Digital Services: Sustaining rural populations and enterprise development through community-owned and future-proofed digital services.

STRATEGIC ACTION 12.2

Digital for Heritage Interpretation: The expansion of heritage site interpretation using digital tools.

Sub-theme (2 d): Rural Youth

Local Objective 13: Youth Initiatives: Sustaining rural populations through supporting programmes and initiatives for rural young people.

STRATEGIC ACTION 13.1

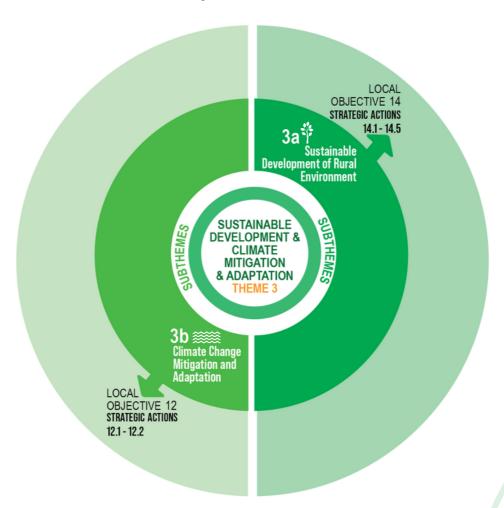
Youth for Climate Action: Supporting rural young people to engage with community development with a focus on a 'care for nature' and climate action.

STRATEGIC ACTION 14.3

Three Sisters River Trust: Developing an umbrella River Catchment Trust for shared interests across the 'Three Sisters' of the Barrow, Nore and Suir in Kilkenny in cooperation with neighbouring counties.
